

# LOCKERS BUYERS GUIDE

If you're a lockers novice then this guide is perfect for you. The choice can sometimes be overwhelming and confusing - so let us help you.

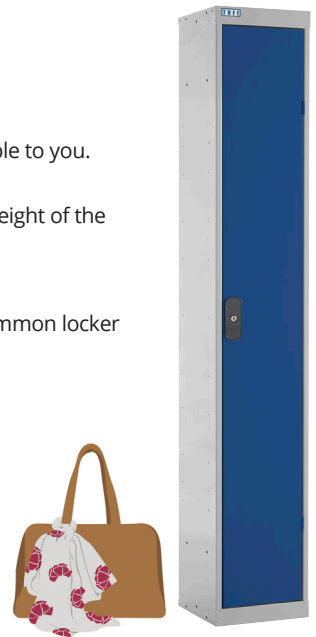
## SIZE

First of all, it is important to establish the space you have to work with. This will determine what lockers are available to you.

A standard metal locker is around 1800mm high (this can vary by a matter of mm depending on the brand). The height of the units only tends to drastically change when it comes to school, laptop storage and some plastic lockers.

A clear idea of what is going to be stored is essential when choosing the width and depth of a locker. Our most common locker sizes are as follows:

- H 1800 x W 300 x D 300mm
- H 1800 x W 300 x D 450mm
- H 1800 x W 380 x D 380mm
- H 1800 x W 380 x D 450mm
- H 1800 x W 450 x D 450mm



## COMPARTMENTS

Secondly, decide on the number of compartments needed. Most standard lockers offer 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 compartment options. Across the internet you may also see compartments be referred to as 'doors'.

Here at Workplace Products we offer units with multiple compartments and only 1 door so its good to always be careful. If you're unsure, our team are ready to answer any questions via live chat.

The number of compartments you choose should be based on what you need to store. The following is a list of items most commonly stored in Lockers, their average sizes and the lockers we recommend:

### A) PERSONAL ITEMS

**SMARTPHONE** = H 144 x W 71 x D 8mm

**Storage** - Personal Effects Lockers (comp. size: H 165 x W 225 x D 360mm)

**TABLET** = H 10 x W 71 x D 8mm

**Charging** - TabBox USB Charging Locker (comp. size: H 95 x W 295 x W 265mm)

**Storage** - Laptop Storage Lockers (comp size: H 100 x W 375 x D 470mm)

**LAPTOP** = H 30 x W 250 x D 350mm

**Charging** - LapBox USB Charging Locker (comp. size: H 95/ 150 x W 370 x D 450mm)

**Storage** - Laptop Storage Lockers (comp. size: H 100 x W 375 x D 470mm)

### B) FILES & BOOKS

**A4 LEVER ARCH FOLDER** = H 320 x W 80 x D 300mm

**Storage** - Probe Activecoat Lockers - 4 door (comp. size: H 380mm)

**AQA TEXT BOOK** = H 191 x W 26 x D 3mm

**Storage** - TUFF Lockers - 6 door (comp size: H 260mm)

**A5 EXERCISE BOOK** = H 210 x W 150 x D 20mm

**Storage** - Probe Activecoat Lockers - 6 door (comp. size: H 245mm)

## C) BAGS

**RUCKSACK** = H 420 x W 300 x D 120mm

**Storage** - Express Budget Lockers - W 300 x D 450mm - 3 door (comp. size: H 510mm)

**HANDBAG** = H 350 x W 300 x D 150mm

**Storage** - Probe Activecoat Lockers - W 380 x D 380mm - 3 door/ 4 door (comp. size: H 530mm/ H380mm)

**CABIN BAG** = H 550 x W 400 x D 240mm

**Storage** - Probe Activecoat Lockers - W 460 x D 460mm - 2 door (comp. size: H 245mm)



## D) CLOTHING

**COATS/ HI VIS** =

**Storage** - Armour Twin Lockers - two full height, half width compartments with double coat hook in each

**SHOES** =

**Footwear** - Probe Activecoat Lockers - 5 door (comp size: H 300mm)

**Workwear & Boots** - Armour Staff Lockers - multi compartment with 1 door for hats, boots + clothes

**PPE** =

**Boots/ Hats (separately)** - Armour PPE Lockers - 4/6 door (comp. size: H 408/ 260mm)

## MATERIAL

Thirdly, decide which type of door your locker will need. Application will have an influence on this decision. The most popular door types available are:

### STEEL

Most standard units have steel doors. Steel is a material suitable for all dry environments and offer high security and longevity.

### LAMINATE

Laminate doors are available a wider range of finishes and colours. Laminate is highly resistant to scratches, rust and dents. Some laminate lockers can be used in wet area applications.

### PLASTIC

Ideal for outdoor storage. Units are designed for use in damp and wet environments, also provides the ability to wash and clean easily.

### TIMBER

Exudes quality and style. Popular in sports and leisure changing facilities.



## LOCK TYPE

### A) CAM LOCK

Other wise known as a key lock and comes as standard on most ranges. Commonly supplied with 2 keys, this option is perfect for repeat single users or lower user counts.

### B) HASP & STAPLE LOCK

Alternatively called a swivel latch, padlock lock etc. This type of lock has been designed for use with a padlock (provided by the user) and is ideal for busy, multi user applications.

### C) COIN RETURN/ RETAIN

Most commonly found in swimming baths and leisure centres. These locks will accept £1 coins and then either return it to the user afterwards or keep it.

### D) COMBI LOCK

Users enter a 4 digit code to access.

### E) DIGITAL KEYPAD LOCK

Simple to programme and designed for single users.
