

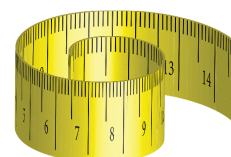
WORKBENCHES BUYERS GUIDE

Our extensive workbench range provides options to satisfy all types of customers. However, we know that on first look our collection can be a bit daunting. Especially for first time shoppers!

Hopefully this guide will help you find the perfect workbenches for you.

SIZES

The most important initial step to work out is the size of workbench(es) you need. This will require you to measure the space you have available to you.



Workbench Height

Our standard workbench height we have available is 840mm, however we offer various sizes ranging from 800mm to 1550mm.



Workbench Width

Our most popular widths are 1200, 1500 & 1800mm benches. These sizes are available on the majority of our ranges but sizes will differ from workbench to workbench.



Workbench Depth

Our depths relate to the size in which the worktop “comes out” from it’s rear to front. Typically, our sizes for this are 600, 750 or 900mm.

WORKTOP OPTIONS

Finding the right worktops for your workbenches will depend on the environment you're working with. Most of our workbenches offer different worktop options but choice may be limited on particular workbenches. Our most popular types are:

LAMINATE

Laminate is our most popular worktop option for its capabilities in general day to use. Its texture means that it's very easy to wipe down after use and has high resistance to oil or forms of grease.



BEECH

Beech is often preferred for Woodworking or DIY use. Most Beech worktops we provide have a thickness of 27mm, making them great for heavy duty requirements.

MFC

Known as our budget option but provides good quality. Grain-like orientation, denser than conventional wood and has high resistance to oils/moisture.



NEOSTAT & LAMSTAT

We have 2 worktops that are designed to prevent static electricity from transferring from the user to the electronic component - Neostat and Lamstat worktops.

Neostat is of a grey synthetic rubber material, whereas the **Lamstat** offers a grey plastic laminate material. Both are specially designed for use in Electrostatic Protected Areas.

ABOVE BENCH

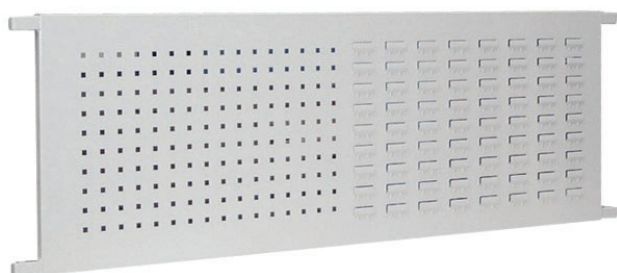
Rear Support Posts (Pair)

Rear Support Posts must be purchased in order to enable the use of most above bench accessories. The pair of posts drill in to the rear legs of some workbenches and are available in H760 or H1180mm.



Back Panels

Panels that can be placed on to Rear Support Posts above the workbench. Great to keep items organised and allows workers to have easy accessibility to equipment. Available with Pin Boards and Louvre Panels combinations.



Lighting

When purchasing the Light/Tool Rail accessory, Lighting can then be added to the workbench. We have Tilting LED Lights, as well as 3-Setting LED lights that will light up a user's workstation. Ideal for workshop areas with poor lighting.

*When adding Lighting, we recommend using the H1880mm Rear Support Posts.

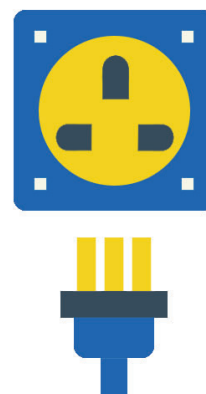

Service Ducts

Service Ducts will enable the user to have power supply. We have 2 types - a Worktop Fitted Service Duct as well as Support Post Fitted Service Duct.

*Please note that you'll need a qualified electrician to fit the power wires to the sockets.

BELOW BENCH

Cupboards

Cupboards can be added below bench to a lot of our popular ranges. Available in various colours such as Blue, Dark Grey, Green and Red. The Cupboards also feature central locking with Keys, ideal when needing to keep tools close but secure to your workbench.



Drawers

Lockable Drawers are also available in various colours. As well as also being available in Single Drawers and Triple Drawer options.

EXTENSION BENCHES

Extension Benches are a great way to add additional size to your working station. These can be placed vertically to your workbench and are a great way to have all your working items an arm length away.



Extension benches can also be accessorised. With many of our customers choosing to add cupboards or drawers to these units.
